## Ingo Maurer – Light – Reaching for the Moon. An exhibition of the Vitra Design Museum

The exhibition concept emerged from a close co-operation with Ingo Maurer. The exhibition comprises of very rare prototypes, serial products, as well as unique one-off designs of the past four decades. By means of models, photographs and films, special lighting projects are presented. Installations and lighting objects have been created especially for this ex-hibition, such as for instance "Tableaux Chinois", "Sym-pho-nia" and "Jour et Nuit". Apart from Weil am Rhein, the exhibition was shown in Copenhagen, Amsterdam, Grand Hornu (Belgium), Valencia, Tsukuba (Ibaraki, Japan) Tokyo and Osaka.
